TYGA FM ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

TYGA FM held its Annual General Meeting on Wednesday 28 October 2015 at the Social Rooms, New Norfolk.

TYGA President Bruce Lamb gave a comprehensive report on the activities and achievements of the station over the past 12 months.

This included –

- Successful outside broadcasts at the Derwent Valley Christmas Parade in December 2014, the Relay for Life in February 2015 and the Derwent Valley Autumn Festival in April 2015.
- Another fabulous trivia night held at the New Norfolk Golf Club in October (see page 2).
- An update on the station modifications, which will see the old tea room converted into an equipment room and production office, freeing up the current production office space to be used as a second studio for backup, training and production.
- We are in the process of moving the antenna and transmission site to Peppermint Hill. This is a five-year project, and when it's finished it should give us better coverage, especially towards Maydena, and improve reception at Granton and Collinsvale.
- We've installed a satellite dish for access to the Community Radio Network. We're now waiting on the installation of equipment to download and save programs to be replayed later.

- TYGA FM will continue to support young people in the field of media studies by providing our annual bursary to a New Norfolk High School student for media training.

The meeting approved an amendment to the constitution of the association to provide for two additional board members. These members will be appointed by the board at a future board meeting.

Bruce also announced that membership fees for adult members will increase to \$22 (\$16.50 for pensioners and concession card holders) for the year commencing 1 July 2016.

TYGA FM continues to support the Derwent Valley Country Music Muster (to be held at Boyer Oval on Saturday 28 November). Several TYGA volunteers are involved in the Muster organising committee, which is now an independent incorporated association.
