CRACKING THE CODE

What you hear on community radio is governed by the Community Radio Codes of Practice which are available from the Community Broadcasting Association website, www.cbaa.org.au. Each newsletter will focus on one of these Codes.



In this issue the focus is on Code 6: Sponsorship. This code requires community radio stations to broadcast no more than five minutes of sponsorship announcements per hour. It also requires stations to ensure sponsors have no influence on editorial decisions affecting the content and style of individual programs and overall station programming.
