## CRACKING THE CODE

What you hear on community radio is governed by the Community Radio Codes of Practice which are available from the Community Broadcasting Association website, [www.cbaa.org.au](http://www.cbaa.org.au). Each newsletter will focus on one of these Codes.



In this issue the focus is on Code 3: General Programming or more specifically code 3.1.

In general code 3.1 requires community radio stations to not broadcast material that may incite or encourage violence or brutality, mislead or alarm listeners, present the use of illegal drugs or other harmful substances as desirable or present suicide as a solution to life problems.

---

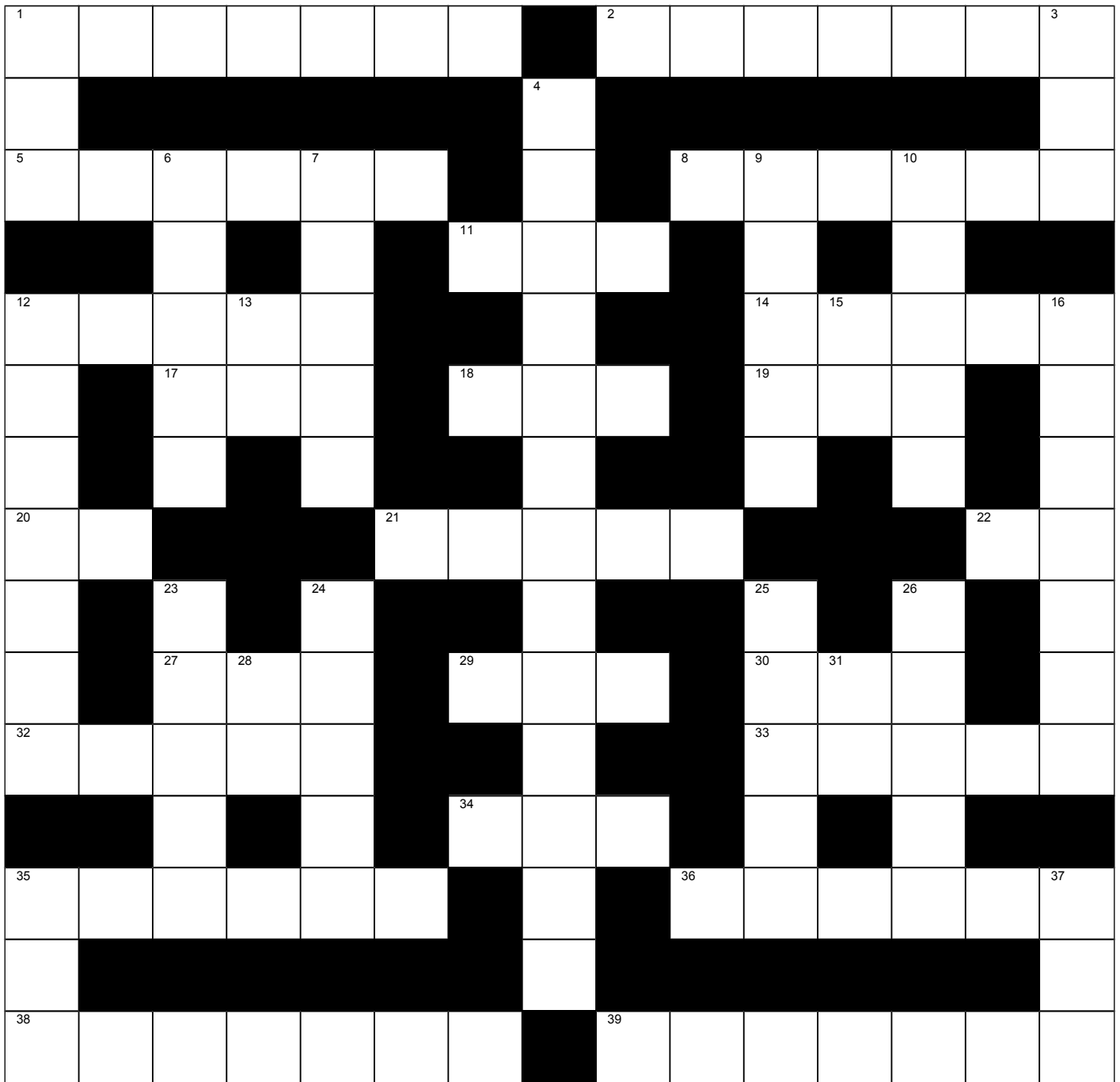
